FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

- Started in 2013
- Two years in public schools as teachers and community leaders
- Reach of over 10,000 public school students annually

PROVEN TO IMPROVE STUDENT
LEARNING OUTCOMES. A study done
by the Massachusetts Institute of
Technology Abdul Latif Jameel Poverty
Action Lab (MIT-JPAL) showed that
TFP-trained teachers achieve
statistically significant positive
increases in their students' learning
outcomes in Math, English, and
Science



AMBASSADORS PROGRAM

- Started in 2015
- One year extension as a Technical Assistant in local and national government agencies to apply community insight to policymaking

ESTABLISHED PIPELINE OF HIGH-PERFORMING TALENT FOR THE GOVERNMENT. As of March 2020, the 210 Alumni who completed the Fellowship, 113 (54%) have entered into local and national government. Of these 51% have been offered permanent positions in agencies, most notably the Department of

- Piloted in 2018
- Two years specialized professional development program for licensed and tenured DepEd teachers
